Your district public health inspector will contact you if more information is required in order to assess the status of your application. No changes from the approved plans are permitted without prior written approval from the Population Health Unit.

^{*}Please note additional permits (e.g. electrical installation, land us clearance, grading, business registration, etc...) may also be required from other agencies.

The plan check process may also include other provincial, regional and municipal departments such as building, zoning and fire department.

*A final approval inspection of all construction and equipment is necessary to begin operation of a personal service facility. Upon health approval operation of the facility can commence.
